IMPORTANT: The Master Thesis project has to be carried out at an NCP-related lab (a research group within the NCP teaching network) or at an external lab/institution in cooperation with an NCP supervisor. The Master Thesis project has to be supervised by a **professor, PD** (i.e., 'Privatdozent'), or a postdoctoral researcher who has started a **"PD-track"**. An equivalent qualification would also be acceptable. The Thesis supervisor must be a **member of the NCP teaching network** (i.e., he or she gave courses in NCP in the previous year). 'External' Master Thesis projects have to be formally approved by the NCP examination board and should be based on existing research collaborations. The official Thesis supervisor must nevertheless be a member of the NCP teaching network.

According to the Examination Guidelines, the Master Thesis project is strongly recommended to start no later than February 22nd in order to enable the student to finish the Master Thesis within the mandatory period (of 23 weeks) until July 26th.

The Master Thesis project should consist of supervised experimental and/ or computational work on a current research issue, documented by a thesis in the format of a journal article. The Master Thesis project will conclude with a written evaluation of the students' performance by the supervisor. This evaluation should be submitted to the LMU Examination Office ('Prüfungsamt') no later than six weeks after the Master Thesis submission deadline. Three hard copies of the Master Thesis report have to be submitted to the Examination Office until the submission deadline. Students will receive 30 credit points for their Master Thesis report. Please register the Thesis project between February 15th and February 22nd.
